

1. 8th graders must report on 300 pages each quarter. Pages in a book count as "reported" when you pass an AR test at 70% for 10-point tests or 65% for 20-point tests. *I may count a 60% at 60% pages for you. Ask.*

Q1: Due by 4 PM on Wednesday, October 25
Q2: Due by 4 PM on Tuesday, January 9
Q3: Due by 4 PM on Monday, March 12
Q4: Due by 4 PM on Tuesday, May 15

- 3. Classroom novels do not count.
- 4. Please bring an AR book to English class *every day*, even if you've already met the requirement. When I think of it, I do periodic pop checks. Being caught without an AR book counts as -10 pages for the quarter.
- You can take AR tests in the Resource Center before or after school.
 Tuck your purple slip into your book & turn both in to my inbox. Your book will be returned to your classroom mailbox with a receipt.
- 6. One non-AR report will be accepted per year. More than one may be accepted with good reason and my permission. Turn the non-AR book in to my basket when you are done reading it so I can review it and write questions for you to answer in paragraph form.
- 7. An AR test is required every quarter, even if you have 300 carryover pages. I want you to keep growing as a reader!
- 8. If you struggle with passing AR tests, have your parent contact me ASAP so we can make a plan together.
- 9. Giving an informal book talk to the class is worth 25 free pages (depending on the quality of the talk). You can do this once per quarter.
